NOTICE OF FILINGS

Notice is hereby given that the **North American Electric Reliability Corporation (“NERC”)** has filed **Reliability Standards** and the **Northeast Power Coordinating Council, Inc. (“NPCC”)** has filed **Regional Reliability Criteria**, for approval by the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board (“Board”) to be mandatory and enforceable for the bulk electric power system within the Province of Nova Scotia. The bulk electric power system in the Province of Nova Scotia is currently operated by Nova Scotia Power Inc.

ANYONE WISHING TO INTERVENE in this matter should file notice of such intention with the Board at: board@gov.ns.ca not later than **Wednesday, August 25, 2010**.

An Order setting the timetable and Directions on Procedure will be issued after August 25, 2010.
