### NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENSED PREMISES 552 SACKVILLE DRIVE, LOWER SACKVILLE, NOVA SCOTIA

Notice is hereby given that the following application will be heard by the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board at a Public Hearing to be held as follows:

Bubin Foods Limited, has filed an application for a Lounge License for the premises known as Angles Family Eatery & Pub located at 552 Sackville Drive, Lower Sackville, Nova Scotia.

The square footage of the proposed Lounge is 1,053 square feet for a patron accommodation of 87 persons.

A portion of the premises is under a separate application for an Eating Establishment Liquor License (Unrestricted) and will be heard prior to the Public Hearing on the Lounge application.

A Lounge License authorizes the Licensee to have liquor purchased from the Nova Scotia Liquor Corporation on the license and to sell to any person nineteen (19) years of age or over the spirits so purchased by the glass, or in the case of beer and wine, by the glass, open bottle or other container for consumption only in the licensed Lounge or other areas licensed by the Board.

Be advised that pursuant to section 71(2) of the *Liquor Licensing Regulations* (the "*Regulations*"), should the Lounge application be successful, the applicant has applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Department of Labour and Workforce Development for approval to use the Eating Establishment seating area as a Lounge after 9:00 p.m. The Eating Establishment of this premises measures 1,268 square feet and can accommodate 105 persons.

This will further advise that, pursuant to sections 4(4)(i) and 4(4)(j) of the *Regulations*, should the Lounge application be successful, the applicant has applied to the Alcohol and Gaming Division of the Department of Labour and Workforce Development for approval to offer non-amplified and amplified (background music) entertainment on the premises.

Maximum days and hours of operation are from 10 o'clock in the forenoon until 2 o'clock in the forenoon of the following day, Monday to Saturday, inclusive. On Sunday, the hours are from 12 noon until 2 o'clock in the forenoon of the following day.

Any person may object to or support the application by making a written submission or filing a petition with the Board not later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 2, 2010 or by appearing at the Hearing, or both.
