DANIEL IRVING ADLER has appealed from a decision of Bridgetown Town Council made April 26, 2010, which approved an amendment to Part 12.1 of the Land Use By-Law, Downtown Commercial (C1) Zone, Permitted Uses to include "private reception, banquet and meeting facility" and approved an application to rezone a portion of 48 Queen Street Bridgetown (PID 05144456), from Institutional (I1) to Downtown Commercial (C1)
