ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: The Utility is proposing a 5% increase to all rates and charges as well as a change to its Residential Rate Availability for service entrances over 200 amps. The Utility is also proposing increases to some of the wiring inspection fees in its Schedule of Rules and Regulations to bring them up to other Nova Scotia utility-approved levels .
