NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Freeman's Little New York Downtown Limited, holder of Eating Establishment Liquor License No. 001866 and Lounge License No. 001867, filed a request with the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board to remove several restrictions imposed on the Licenses by the Nova Scotia Alcohol and Gaming Authority in relation to the premises known as Little New Yorker, located at 3671 Dutch Village Road, Halifax, Nova Scotia. This application will be heard as follows:

COMMENCING: Tuesday, June 7, 2011 at 10:00 a.m.

1601 Lower Water Street, Halifax, Nova Scotia

The Nova Scotia Alcohol and Gaming Authority previously imposed the following three (3) conditions on the Licenses:

2. Service of liquor in the licensed premises will cease at 12:00 o'clock midnight with one half hour to vacate the premises.
3. There will be no live bands performing in the premises.
4. The doors to the outside will remain closed during the hours of operation so that the noise normally associated with licensed premises will not emanate from the building.

The Licensee has requested that the above outlined conditions be removed from the Licenses.

The Board has determined that the request warrants a public hearing.
